College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)
SY 2014-15

About the CCRPI:

As documented in the District Accountability System's Reporting, Evaluating, & Monitoring Instrument (DAS-REMI), a Key Performance Outcome for Goal 1 is to increase the district's CCRPI score. The CCRPI is a comprehensive school improvement and communication platform that serves as the overarching measure of school, district, and state performance for federal and state accountability purposes. The CCRPI includes multiple categories and indicators within the core components of Academic Achievement, Student Progress, and Achievement Gap, as well as opportunities to earn Challenge Points through student Subgroup Performance and attainment of specialized Exceeding the Bar indicator targets.

The SY 2014-15 CCRPI calculation is the first to reflect results from the Georgia Milestones Assessment System (GMAS). In addition to the transition from CRCT/EOCT to GMAS, the SY 2014-15 CCRPI calculation includes a number of other significant changes from prior years' CCRPI calculation methods, as summarized below:

1. Changes to component weights, with Progress increasing from 25 to 40 possible points, while Achievement decreased from 60 to 50 points, and Achievement Gap decreased from 15 to 10 points
2. Progress component changed to a benchmarked measure, with target set at the 95th percentile of performance across the state rather than at 100%
3. Achievement Gap – Gap Change calculation changed to reflect mean Student Growth Percentile for lowest-performing quartile of students rather than year-to-year difference in Gap Size
4. Subgroup performance targets and all benchmarked indicator targets reset to reflect the new baseline
5. Points earned for GMAS-based measures are weighted by performance level, with Developing scores weighted at 0.5, Proficient scores weighted at 1.0, and Distinguished scores weighted at 1.5
6. Elimination of stand-alone reading and writing indicators at the elementary and middle levels due to integration of reading, English/language arts, and writing within the GMAS
7. High School Achievement Post Readiness indicator measuring graduates' pathway completion status updated to include IB Career-Related Certificates



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8. High School Achievement Post Readiness indicator measuring the percentage of students reaching the Exceeds level on the EOCT updated to reflect students at Proficient or Distinguished on GMAS and target updated to 100% rather than benchmarked at 95th percentile
9. Elementary and Middle School Predictor for Graduation indicator measuring students passing all state-tested subject areas and all core courses eliminated
10. Elementary and Middle School Predictor for Graduation indicator measuring the percentage of students reaching the Exceeds level on the CRCT updated to reflect students at Proficient or Distinguished on GMAS and target updated to 100% rather than benchmarked at 95th percentile; due to elimination of other Predictor for Graduation indicator as noted in #9, this lone indicator serves as the Predictor for Graduation measure, and accounts for 30% of the Achievement component score
11. Attendance indicator for all grade level bands changed from an overall attendance rate to the percentage of students absent fewer than 6 days, and benchmarked at 95th percentile

Due to the transition from CRCT/EOCT to GMAS and the extent of the other CCRPI calculation changes, SY 2014-15 CCRPI scores are not comparable to those from prior years, and reflect a new baseline of performance state-wide.

CCRPI SY 2014-15 – Key Points

- For SY 2014-15, SCCPSS earned an overall CCRPI score of 65.4. All grade level clusters scored above 60, with elementary grades earning a score of 64.1, middle grades earning a 61.0, and high school grades achieving an overall score of 72.5.
- At all grade level clusters, SCCPSS earned the greatest amount of points within the Progress component – 31.2 of 40 possible points among elementary grades; 32.4 of 40 among middle grades; and 34.1 of 40 at high school grade levels.
- SCCPSS outscored its comparison group of demographically similar districts in the Achievement, Subgroup Performance, and Exceeding the Bar components in grades K-5. SCCPSS earned more Exceeding the Bar points than its comparison group in grades 6-8.
- Among elementary schools, overall scores ranged from 43.8 to 89.6. Heard, Howard, JG Smith, and Marshpoint surpassed the state's overall K-5 score, and Bloomingdale, Butler, CEMCO, Gadsden, Heard, Howard, JG Smith, Largo-Tibet, Juliette Low, Marshpoint, Pulaski, Southwest, Spencer, Thunderbolt, Tybee, West Chatham, White Bluff, and Windsor Forest each exceeded the state average in at least one of the CCRPI components (Achievement, Progress, Achievement Gap, Subgroup Performance, or Exceeding the Bar).
- K8 schools' overall scores ranged from 38.5 to 84.5, with Ellis, Garrison, and Hesse surpassing the state in at least one grade level band. All SCCPSS non-charter K8 schools outperformed the state average in one or more CCRPI components.



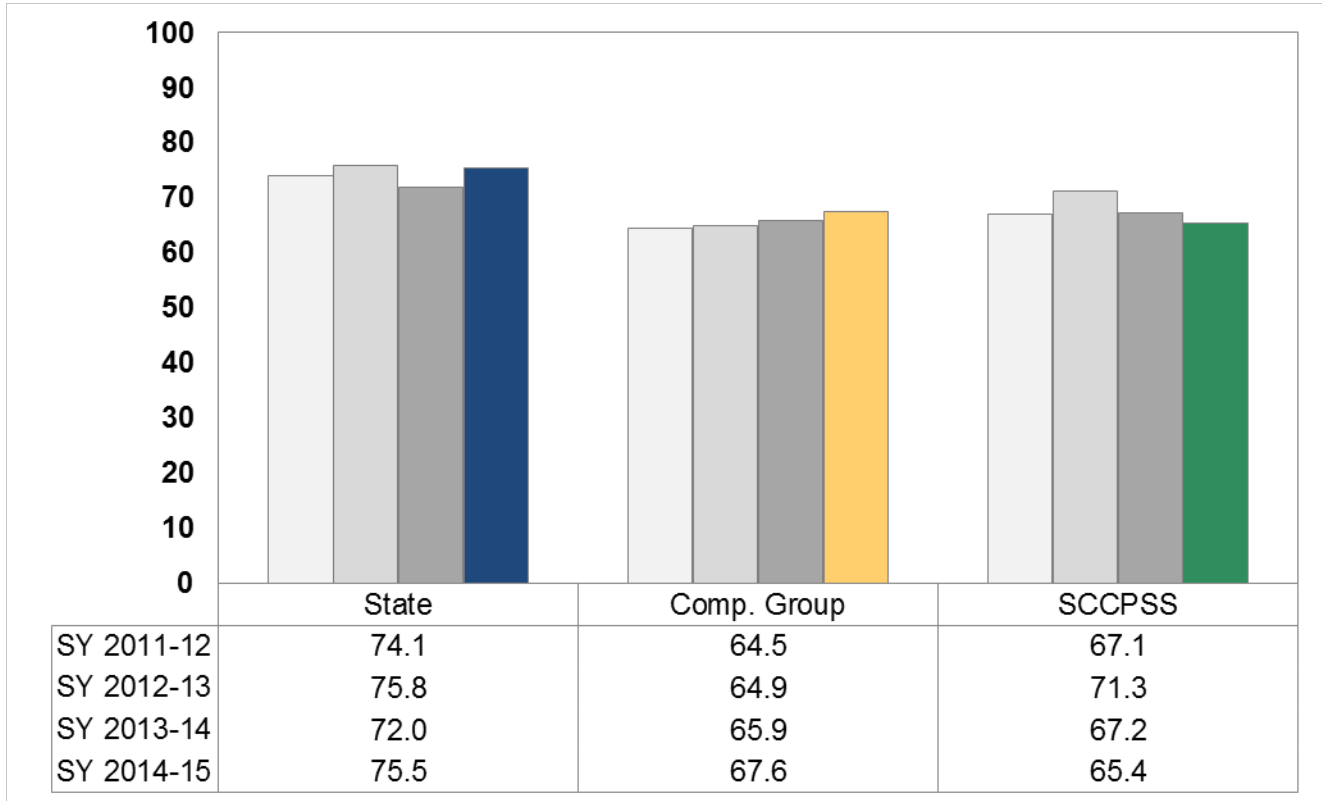
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- Middle schools' overall scores ranged from 47.6 to 84.5. STEM and Oglethorpe met or exceeded the state score for grades 6-8, and all SCCPSS middle schools outperformed the state in at least one CCRPI component.
- At the high school level, SCCPSS outperformed its comparison group of demographically similar districts overall and within the Achievement, Achievement Gap, and Subgroup Performance components.
- Among SCCPSS high schools, overall scores ranged from 60.6 to 92.3. Islands, Savannah Arts, and Woodville-Tompkins outperformed the state, and Beach, Groves, Islands, New Hampstead, and Savannah Arts each exceeded the district in one or more CCRPI components. Woodville-Tompkins exceeded the state in all CCRPI components, and earned the highest overall CCRPI score in the district.



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Figure 1. State, Comparison Group, & SCCPSS CCRPI Overall Score

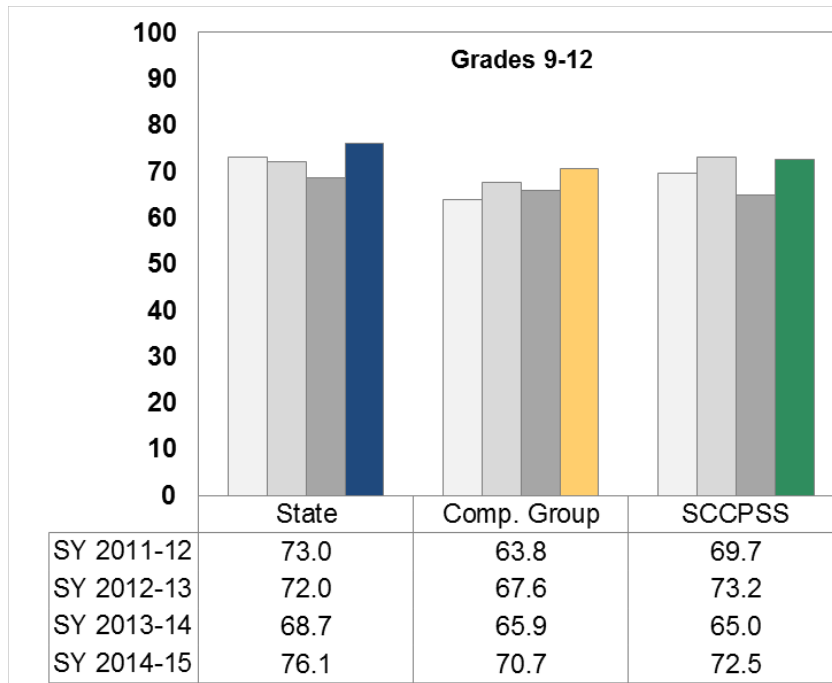
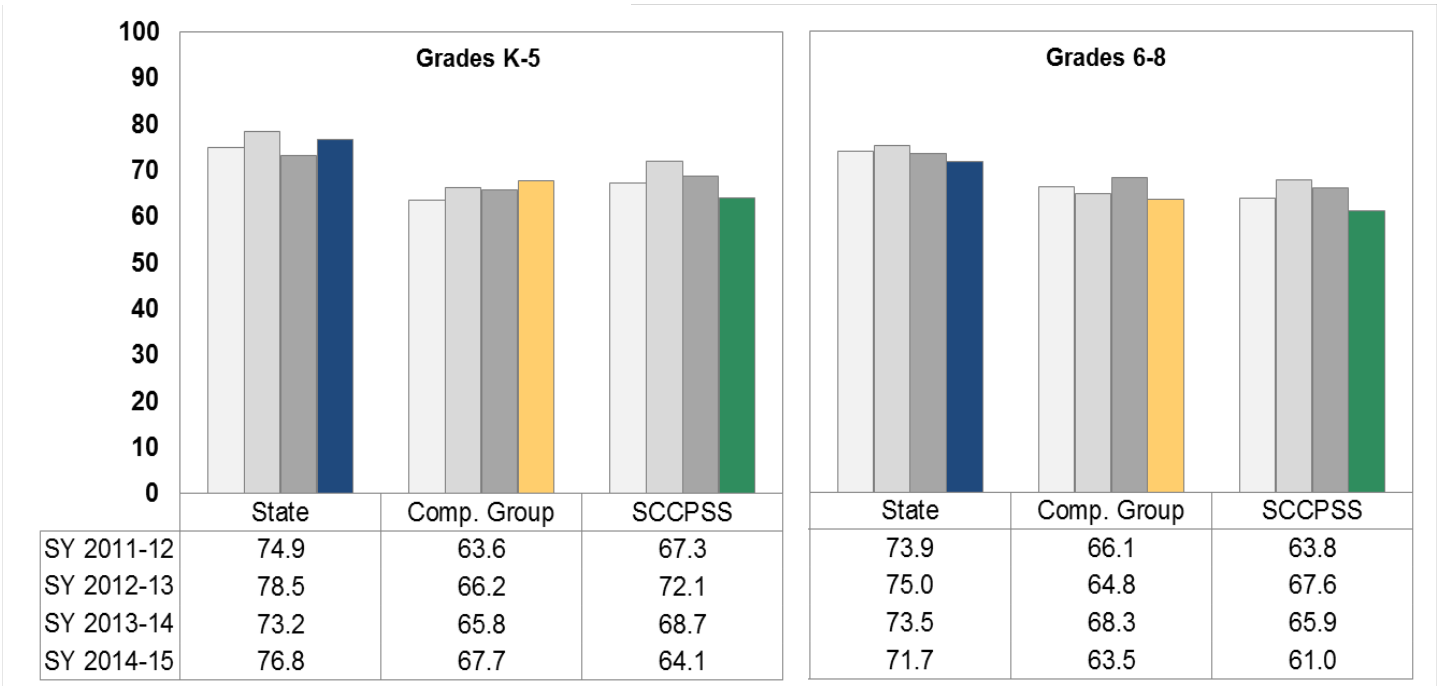
