

SCCPSS Ongoing Independent Learning Plan

OVERVIEW

As a result of our extended emergency school closure, students will continue their learning through **Independent Learning Days**. This will allow our students to learn at home through digital instructional activities. Teachers will provide assignments via Google Classroom, Edmodo, Microsoft Teams, Schoology, Zoom, or another electronic platform they have used with their students this year. Teachers will be available for virtual "office hours" during which time they will provide instruction, offer guidance on instructional tasks, and be available to answer questions.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Designate a workspace for students with necessary supplies (electronic device, paper, pencil, etc.).
- Set a schedule for student work to include breaks and free time.
- Make sure students can access their digital platform or that they have their printed Independent Learning Packet.
- **Elementary** students can expect 1-2 hours of work per day.
- **Middle and High** students can expect 2-3 hours of work per day.

REQUIREMENTS

- Students will receive assignments via Google Classroom, Edmodo, Microsoft Teams, Schoology, Zoom, or other electronic platforms that students have used this year.
- All assignments will be clearly labeled with subject and due date.
- In some cases, assignments may take more than one day for completion.
- At minimum, student work will be graded with at least one grade per week, per subject/course. See **Board Regulation IHA-R (1)**.

DIGITAL ACCESS CONCERNS

- If digital access is not available at home, Independent Learning Packets will be available for pick-up at the entrance of each school site beginning Monday, April 6 through Friday, April 10. Each Independent Learning Packet contains a weekly schedule for work completion for up to 5 weeks.
- After April 10, packets may be picked up from the Student and Family Services Center located at Formey School on 400 East Broad Street in Savannah. Call 912 395-5584.
- Assignment return will be established between the parent and teacher for the purpose of grading. Student work to be graded may be submitted via photo, emailed, or scanned to the teacher.
