



# Savannah-Chatham County Public Schools

## Step 1

Contact your high school counselor  
October 15th for Spring Semester  
May 1st for Summer term and Fall Semester

## Step 2

**CREATE** a GAFutures account using a personal email account **NOT** your school's email account. Click this link <https://www.gafutures.org/> and create an account on GAFutures. You **DO NOT** need the GTID to create the account. But you will need to know your **SOCIAL SECURITY** number.

## Step 3

Complete the admissions application for the institution you are interested in attending. Use the College Planning tab on <https://www.gafutures.org/college-planning/>. You must be accepted by the college/university to participate. **Be sure you apply as a DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENT**, so you WILL NOT be asked to **pay an application fee**.

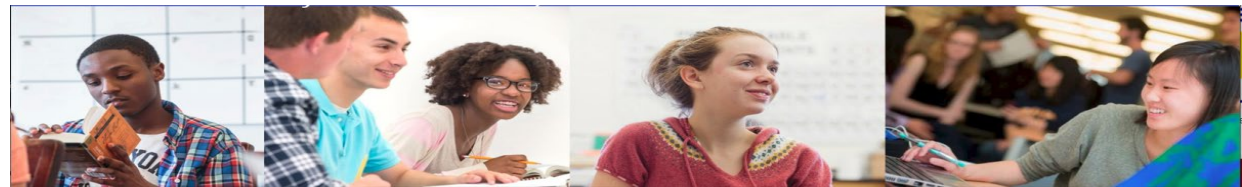
## Step 4

**REQUEST YOUR TRANSCRIPT** on GAFutures to be sent to the institution you are applying to from the home page on GAFutures. You will see the link to request your transcript under the avatar on the main page of your GAFutures account.

## Step 5

**COMPLETE THE FUNDING APPLICATION** (you will need a parent's email address as well as your own personal email account, NOT your schools' email). <https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/scholarships-grants/dual-enrollment/application-procedure-and-deadline/>

- Core academic courses (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language)
- Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) courses (i.e. Welding, Cosmetology, Patient Care Technician, Automotive Technology)
- 11th and 12th grade students
  - Limited exceptions for other students include
    - 10th grade students may take approved CTAE courses
    - 10th grade students with a minimum 1200 SAT score or a 26 ACT score may participate
- 30 semester hours or 45 quarter hours
- Pays tuition, books, and some fees
- Students may not receive funding for the same course twice
- Students are ineligible for future dual enrollment funding after their 2nd course withdrawal
- All classes, pass or fail, will be added to the student's transcript and calculated into his/her GPA. A=100, B=90, C=80, D=75, F, WF, W=65 (SCCPSS grading scale; includes district bonus points)
