<b>QUESTION:</b>	<b>SCCPSS RESPONSE:</b>
See attached handwritten question #1	SCCPSS recognizes the importance hands-on experiential learning in respect to CTAE based coursework. The impacts of the pandemic have provided challenges for all students, especially in situations where a move to virtual learning was required. To overcome learning barriers, the District's CTAE Department provided additional supplies, technology, and small equipment for students while they were learning virtually. Cloud-based instructional resources were also provided, and students were able to demonstrate their skills (virtually). Teachers were also cleared to allow small groups of students on campus while socially distanced to demonstrate skills that they could not complete at home. Through effective planning and response, students were able to receive high levels of teaching and learning through unprecedented times. SCCPSS is proud of the academic achievements our students exhibit daily. The District's CTAE pathway graduation rate is an indicator of exemplary outcomes as the <b>SCCPSS 2021 CTAE Pathway Graduation Rate</b> has outpaced the state average and is now <b>98.11%</b> !
See attached handwritten question #2	Please refer to Answer in #1. SCCPSS also engages extensively with the local business community and receives excellent input and support <u>annually</u> through the Career Education Advisory Council.
See attached handwritten question #3	A common practice that is in line with the District's strategic goals includes the commitment to provide district-based opportunities for students through job related functions. SCCPSS has hired and provided compensation to over 100 students who work across various departments within the school district. There are also over 100 students in Youth Apprenticeship positions, and over 500 students in the Work Based Learning program. Other successful initiatives through strategic workforce partnerships include the Maritime Logistic Education Taskforce, work-based partnerships with Gulfstream, Y.E.S. through the Georgia Ports Authority, and each year the District organizes a Fall & Spring Student Job Fair.
